Accompanying that salute will be a feature article by Chris Gardner advising older job seekers and other workers on what they need to do to stay competitive in today's difficult job market. Gardner, an entrepreneur and motivational speaker, is the author of "The Pursuit of Happyness" and is AARP's Ambassador of Pursuit and Happyness.
